Retail awards recognize sales growth, great customer service and community involvement

Since its opening, the store has contributed to various efforts, including a donation to the Hudsonville-Jenison Community Foundation in support of the Grand River Greenway Campaign, another to Jamestown's Patmos Library to build a new teen creative room, and a donation to Hudsonville High School to support its schoolwide Kids Food Basket events.

"The Hudsonville community is so welcoming. This last year has been an awesome experience," he said. "I feel like I've worked for this company my whole career because of how welcoming everyone has been."

Samaniego said developing his team is the focus behind his leadership style.

"As you grow in your career, you come to understand that it's not about you. It's about what I can do for my team," he said. "Being the leader of the store is great but having the opportunity to work with such great people every day is even better. It's hard work every day, but we do have fun and the team can feel that."

The awards will be announced in May at FMI's Future Leaders eXperience conference. In addition, Samaniego qualifies to be a part of the online <u>People's Pick Award contest</u> that kicks off today and ends at 2 p.m. April 26. At the end of the week, the nominee with the most votes will win a special trophy and \$500 to celebrate their store team members.
