ENRICHING THE COMMUNITY

- Meijer hired more than 1,000 team members in Illinois in 2014, adding to the nearly 5,000 employees across 18 Chicagoland stores
- Meijer employs nearly 300 full- and part-time team members at each of its 23 Illinois stores
- Meijer donates more than 6 percent of its net profit to charitable organizations each year
- Meijer has a longstanding commitment to supporting local growers and buying local when available and when the quality meets Meijer standards. Meijer currently purchases produce from seven Illinois growers
 - The locally grown program has a total economic impact of more than \$80 million annually throughout five states
- The Meijer *Simply Give* program has generated more than \$15.5 million to help local food pantries serve hungry families
