



South Pennsylvania Ave. Lansing Meijer Remodel

Fact Sheet

In 2013, Meijer invested more than \$160 million in new and remodeled stores. The investment included the construction of six new Meijer supercenters and five major remodel projects, including the Meijer on S. Pennsylvania Ave. in Lansing.

The project entailed tearing down the existing store in phases and building new in its place, resulting in a brand new store that opened in April 2014. The grocery and pharmacy areas remained intact at all times during the construction process. The new store is the same size as the previous store, but a redesigned interior layout now features increased sales floor space for products.

Final interior projects are slated for completion in November 2014.

Project Highlights include:

- A new, drive-up pharmacy will be built to add a level of convenience for Meijer shoppers.
- The new store will be built to Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) compliant standards, and all the steel and concrete from the existing building will be recycled.
- The store will feature polished concrete floors in the food and home areas, and tile floor will be utilized in the softlines area.
- The garden center will be relocated from the back of the existing store to the east side to provide easier access for customers.
- The electronics department will be redesigned for easier access to electronic items and music selections.
- The new store will feature an external bottle return area.
- The Central Area Transportation Authority (CATA) bus terminal will be relocated to the west side of the store, and will be completely rebuilt and will feature improvements that include increased space for patrons to place their belongings.
- A new gas station will also be featured.
