As the first in the nation to implement the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's 2010 near-zero emissions technology standards, the Meijer fleet of 170 semi-trucks demonstrates the company's commitment to utilizing innovative technologies to reduce its carbon footprint. Today, the retailer's fleet meets or exceeds those stringent federal requirements, making it one of the largest all-clean diesel fleets in North America. The trucking fleet's use of innovative technology has improved fuel efficiency and reduced its carbon footprint by nearly 60 percent since it first began implementing the near-zero emissions standards 3 years ago.
